Assessment

Learners are continuously assessed by the Trainer/Assessor. Learners attending this course should be aware of the responsibilities of a First Aider. All learners will be assessed whilst demonstrating first aid skills in a real-life scenario, they will therefore be required to kneel on the floor during recovery and CPR assessment. Learners will also have to successfully pass an end of course multiple-choice questionnaire in order to be certificated.



Refresher Training

The HSE recommends learners update their skills annually.

Certification

On completion of the course learners receive a Full Paediatric First Aid certificate valid for 3 years, which meets OFSTED / EYFS and HSE requirements and an Level 3 Award in Emergency Outdoor First Aid (RQF).
